

# Historic Skills Classes - Info and Policies

---



Thank you in advance for your understanding and following all policies. Follow the guidelines of the CDC and stay home if you feel sick.

- All participants are required to wear masks when inside buildings.
- To keep class size small, only registered participants will be admitted to the program.
- Upon arrival, all participants will be asked to wash and sanitize hands.
- All craft items are sanitized before and after use. Where possible, each participant will have their own set of materials.

## Registration

- Advance registration required. Registration closes at noon 1 week before the class date. If a class falls on Saturday, registration closes on the Friday one week prior.
- Class fees are all-inclusive, meaning there is no additional cost for materials.
- Most classes are for participants aged 18 and up.
- Family classes are offered for youths with accompanying adults. Age limitations vary based on the class. A youth participant must be accompanied by an adult and both adult and teen must have a ticket and register for the class.

## Member discount

Members receive an exclusive early registration period, and a 15% discount on class fees. To receive the discount for members, the purchaser must be a current member of LHF.

## Communication

Approximately 1 week prior to class, you will receive a reminder email that includes details and directions for your class.

## Refund and Cancellation Policies

- Cancellations must be submitted in writing to [education@lhf.org](mailto:education@lhf.org).
- No refund is given for a cancellation made less than 10 business days prior to the class.
- Cancellations occurring at least 10 business days prior to the class will be refunded the purchase price less a 50% cancellation fee.
- If a program runs as scheduled, no refund will be given for your absence.
- If the National Weather Service issues a severe weather warning and travel is not advised, the class will be cancelled and participants will receive a 100% refund.
- If a class must be cancelled due to low registration, registered participants will receive a 100% refund.
