

# Historic Skills Classes: Info and Policies



## ILLNESS PREVENTION

Follow the guidelines of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and stay home if you feel sick. In addition, all class participants are strongly encouraged to follow the museum's guidelines to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, including wearing masks indoors. Read the museum's full statement [here](#). Please also be aware of these policies:

- Only registered participants will be allowed in class.
- Upon arrival, all participants will be asked to wash and sanitize their hands.
- When possible, each participant will have their own supplies, materials, tools, etc., which will not be shared. Before and after use, these materials will be cleaned and sanitized.

## REGISTRATION

- Some restrictions apply. Check specific class descriptions for details.
- Fee per person:
  - Varies by class. See descriptions.
  - Is all-inclusive, meaning there is no additional cost for materials.
  - Must be paid in full at time of purchase.
  - Is discounted by 15% discount for members. Members are also eligible for an exclusive early registration period. Purchase or renew your membership [here](#).
- Number of participants varies by class. Check descriptions.
- Age restrictions:
  - Most classes are for ages 18 and up.
  - "Learn Together" classes are open to a youth with an adult. Age limits vary. Youth who attend must be accompanied by an adult. Adult and teen must be separately registered.
- Advance registration is required. We want to have enough supplies on hand!
- Registration closes at noon one week before the class date. If a class falls on a Saturday or Sunday, registration closes on the Friday one week prior. If the minimum number of registrations is not met, the class will be canceled.
- Approximately one week prior to class, you will receive an email with details and directions.

## CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Cancellation by a participant:

- Must be sent in writing to [education@lhf.org](mailto:education@lhf.org).
- More than 10 business days: 50% cancellation fee
- 10 business days or fewer: No refund
- If a class runs and participant does not attend, no refund is given.

Cancellation by Living History Farms:

- Weather—If the National Weather Service issues a severe weather warning and travel is not advised, class will be canceled and participants will receive a 100% refund.
- Enrollment—If class is canceled due to low registration, registered participants will receive a 100% refund.
