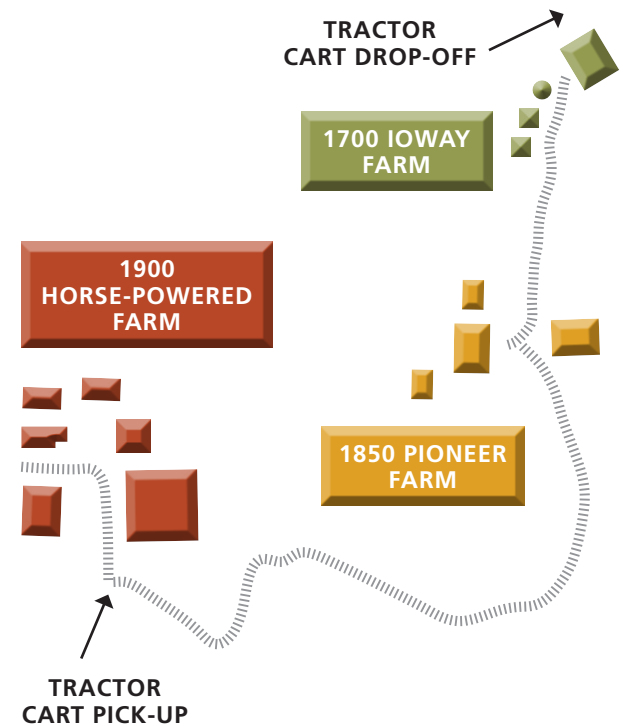

ACCESSIBILITY INFORMATION

Once you enter the museum grounds, all paths are boardwalk or dirt/gravel. None are paved.

To cut down on travel between farm sites, you can (a) request a Step Saver tour from your tractor driver, which eliminates the $\frac{3}{10}$ mile woodland trail between the 1850 and 1900 farms, or (b) request to visit the 1900 farm only, which also eliminates the $\frac{1}{10}$ mile dirt path hill between the 1700 and 1850 farms.

In town, visiting all the buildings involves a $\frac{3}{4}$ mile loop of boardwalk and dirt/gravel path. All buildings have accessible entrances, although these are not always the front entrances. Please ask staff to point out the accessible entrance if needed. The one spot that is not accessible without climbing stairs is the second floor of the Flynn Mansion, which is on the National Historic Register and therefore does not meet ADA guidelines.

In addition to the modern restrooms indicated on this map, there are modern restrooms at the 1900 Farm house and the Flynn Mansion. Please ask staff if you need access to these restrooms.
